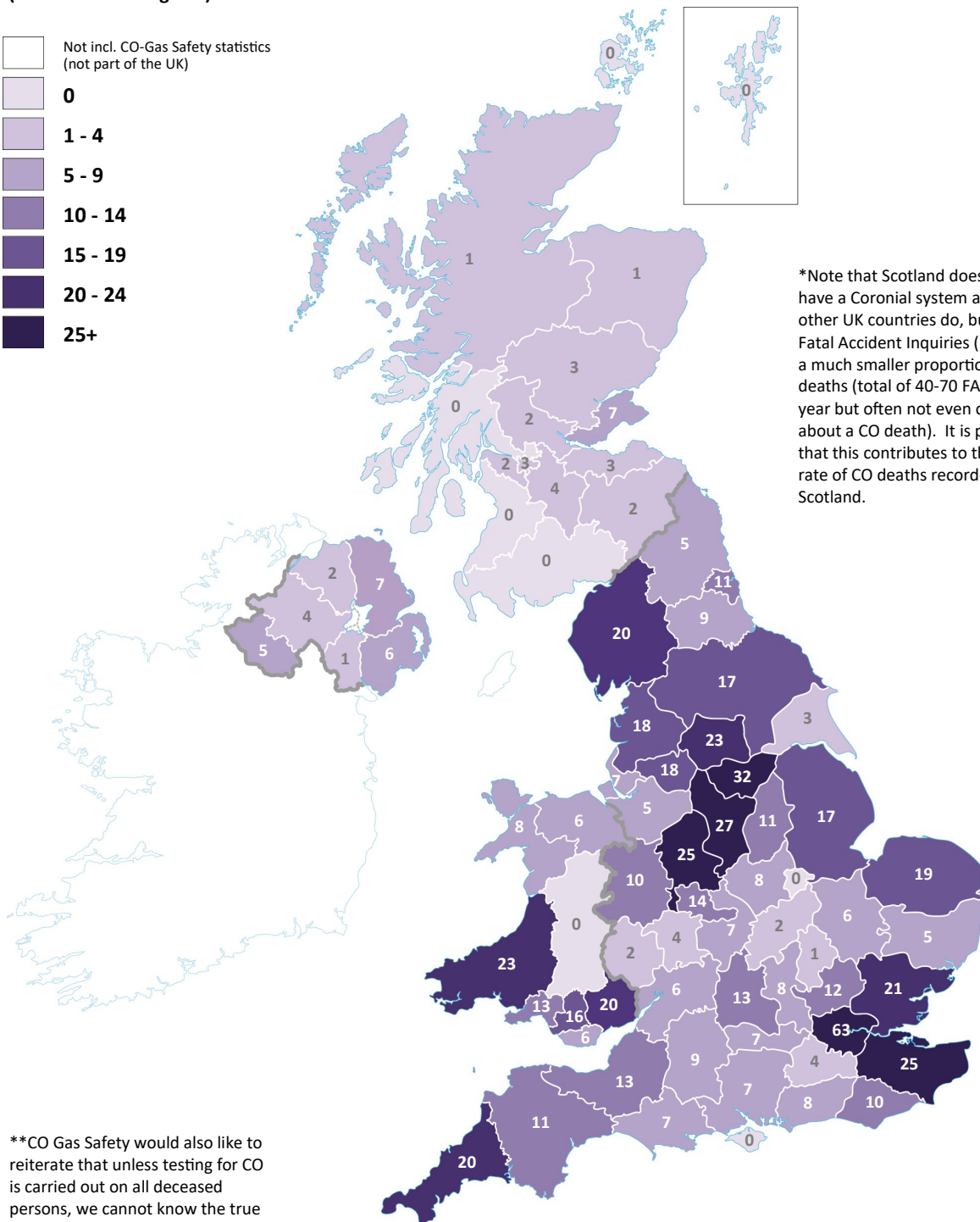
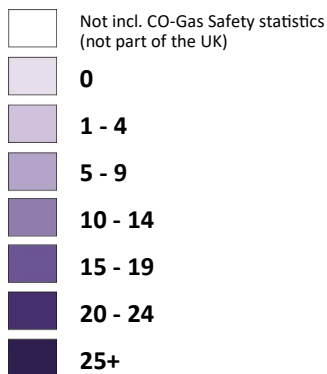


LOCATION OF INCIDENT relating to UK deaths from unintentional carbon monoxide poisoning from 01.09.1995 to 31.08.2020

Number of deaths recorded in each administrative area (actual number is given)



*Note that Scotland does not have a Coronial system as the other UK countries do, but holds Fatal Accident Inquiries (FAIs) for a much smaller proportion of deaths (total of 40-70 FAIs per year but often not even one FAI about a CO death). It is possible that this contributes to the lower rate of CO deaths recorded in Scotland.

**CO Gas Safety would also like to reiterate that unless testing for CO is carried out on all deceased persons, we cannot know the true number of unintentional carbon monoxide poisoning deaths within any of the UK countries.
