



## CO GAS SAFETY – CO AWARENESS COMPETITION 2021 FOR JERSEY ONLY

### Rules

1. We're asking young people aged 5 to 18 years old to raise awareness of this deadly poison by producing an informative and accurate warning of the dangers of Carbon Monoxide (CO) poisoning and/or products of combustion and/or how to avoid them.

Your entry can be in ANY media (e.g. film, poem, poster, short story, model). The only limit's your imagination so get creative ...

2. CO can be produced by any carbon based fuel - coal, gas, wood, petrol, diesel etc, - that's used to heat, cook or power appliances & engines in houses, boats, vehicles, 'planes etc.
3. Enter your age group: Key Stage 1 (ages 5-7); Key Stage 2 (ages 8-11) & 12-18.
4. Use any medium (paints, crayons, painting, photographs, video films etc.) provided it's your individual & original work. You may enter as a group up to three provided everyone's names are given - see 6 below.
5. Consult books or Internet for information or ideas but no credit is given for material you've simply taken from the computer or photocopied, copied etc.

Please ensure photos or scans are in colour and don't cut off part of your entry.

Please find space to add name/s & age/s and name & post code of the school on the entry or accompanying email text.

If a photo, scan or email is not possible or won't do your entry justice, please tell us as we may be able to arrange collection.

7. **Competition entries must be with us by midnight, Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021**
8. Winners win prizes and your work may be used in media to raise awareness.
9. The judges' decision on all matters is final with no correspondence entered into on any matter. However, we will try to clarify any ambiguities notified by email to [office@co-gassafety.co.uk](mailto:office@co-gassafety.co.uk) and may amend rules from time to time.

10. Prizes:

- £150 for each winner & £300 for each winner or winning group's school or organisation
- £50 for runner up in each category

11. If you're being home educated and win, your parents can nominate a school or a Local Education Authority to receive the winning prize for your 'school or organisation'.

Organisations of relevant age groups can also enter, such as scouts, guides, youth club etc. and nominate themselves as the 'school or organisation' to receive the prize.

12. If you win you agree to attend a prize presentation at a venue, probably in your local area before end of Autumn term 2021.

Worldwide copyright for work submitted remains with you but, by entering, you agree to give permission as author for us to hold, process and display your work on our website, social media accounts and other media. Your entry will always be credited and we will use entries to raise awareness in a way which does not bring your, your school or organisation into disrepute.
